Software engineering majors must declare a domain track by Fall of their Junior Year. If student has a minor or major in discipline other than software engineering or computer science, then their domain track requirement will be met with the completion of the major or minor courses.

When declaring a domain track (including major or minor), the student must complete a Domain Track Declaration Form (DTDF) stating the selected domain track, and indicate the requisite courses to be taken. If a second major or a minor is being used in lieu of the domain track, that must be listed instead.

Once completed (or any time a substantial change is made to the DTDF), this DTDF must be approved and signed as listed above. Three copies of the DTDF are made:

1. One for the advisor, one for the student's files, and one for Software Engineering program director's files.
2. The original DTDF is provided to the registrar for update of the student's plan of study.
